Dates	14 <sup>th</sup> and 15 <sup>th</sup> of September 2019
Special Notes	The Range holds a maximum of 15 Targets so EARLY ENTRY IS ADVISED.  In order to try and ensure that all Archers have an equal amount of space on the Shooting Line, the centre of the space available to each Archer will be marked and it is requested that when setting their feet/scope markers, and when shooting, Archers stand with the centre of their bodies above this mark

Registration	AGB Membership Cards will be inspected at Registration which will take place on both days at the Club Hut from 0800
Event Timing	Assembly at 0900 both days followed by Practise.  Saturday: As this is a WRS double 50/70m round, there will be two ends of practice before the first session only. There will be no practice after lunch.  There will be a 5 minute warning given before the start of Practise.  Sunday: Practise of up to 45 minutes from 0915.  Both the WA 50/70m Rounds and the Ladies and Gents WA 1440 Rounds will be shot in a double detail with six arrows shot in four minutes all throughout the day.
Event Format	Saturday: The WA 50m Compound Round will be shot on Individual six zone 80cm Faces.  Sunday: All Bow types will shoot on individual six zone 80cm faces at 50 and 30m
Awards	Medals will be awarded to all Bow Types on both days, including separate Ladies, Gentlemen awards. On Saturday the Awards will be based on the total of the scores of both Rounds. On Sundays the Awards will be based on the scores of the WA 1440 Round
Juniors	Juniors will shoot on an equal footing with Senior Archers and there are no separate awards
Dress	Archery GB Rules of Shooting Rule 307 will apply.
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
Photograph	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy, any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography should register their details with Tournament Organiser at the registration desk before carrying out any such photography.
Refreshments	Hot food and Drinks will be available both days with complementary drinks at the morning and afternoon breaks on both days – To help prevent waste please bring your own cup.
Smoking	Those attending the shoot who wish to smoke, are requested to do so on the far side to the track where ashtrays will be provided. This includes those using electronic cigarettes and vapes.
